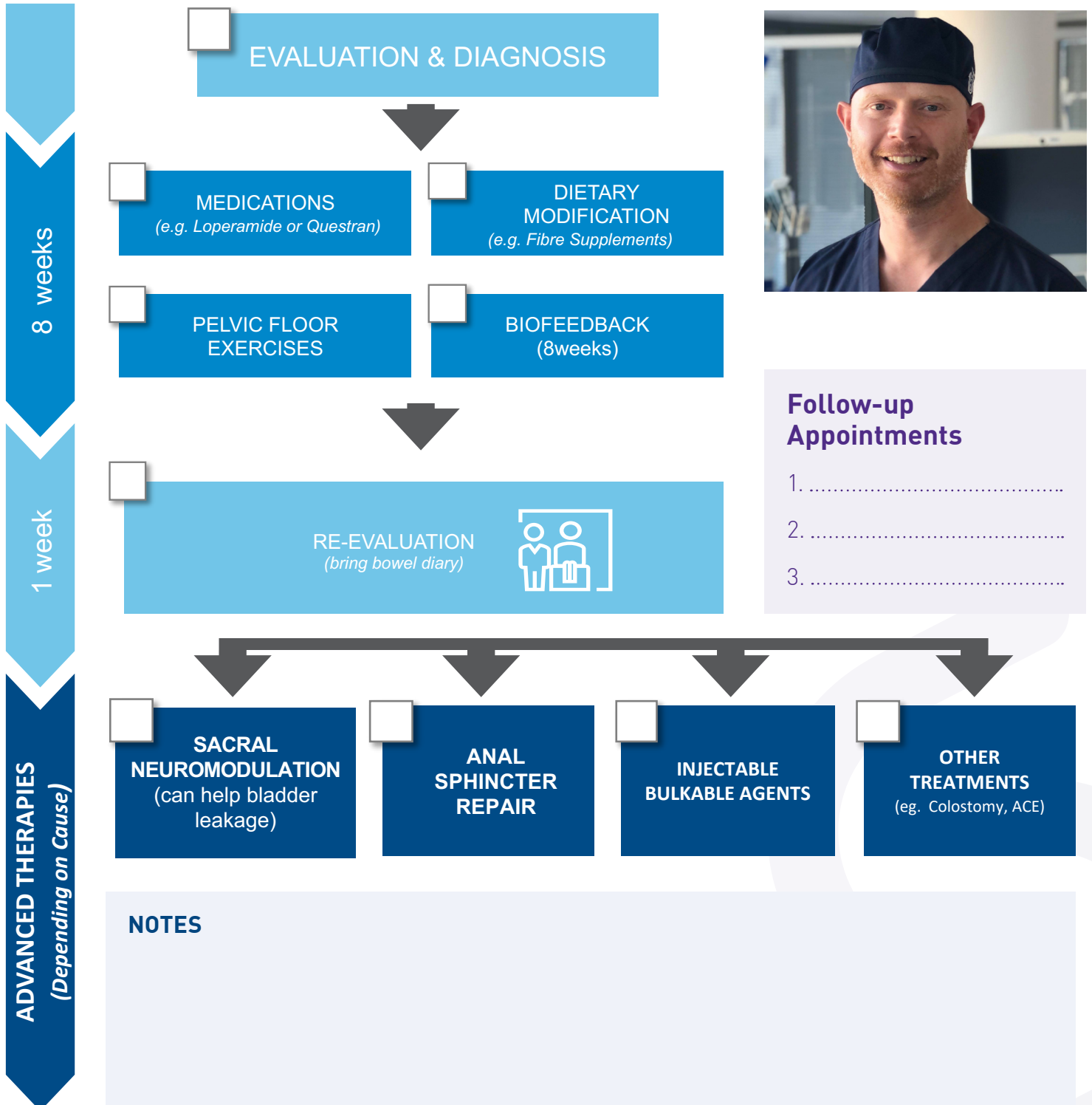


BOWEL CARE PATHWAY
